

## University College London: Location

Square 3A on map.

*Nearest Tube Stations:*

Euston Square (Circle, District and Metropolitan Lines), by the number "3" [Note that the "Sq" has been covered by the number "3"]

Euston (Northern and Victoria Lines), Square 2A

Warren Street (Northern and Victoria Lines), just off map to left, along 'Line 3'.



The Johnston-Lavis Meeting will be held on the ground floor of the Roberts (Engineering) building, immediately next to UCL's side entrance in Torrington Place (south end; circle in Square A4 on map).

## Getting to Central London

### From Heathrow Airport

1. A regular underground (tube) service operates linking the 4 terminals to Central London via the Piccadilly Line (from c. 06.00- c.23.30). Journey Time: c. 50 mins.
2. A fast overground service (every 15 minutes during the day, restricted service at night. Journey Time: c. 15-20 mins) to Paddington Station, where you can change to the underground on the Circle, or Hammersmith Lines, going eastbound until Euston Square (10 mins on underground).

### From Gatwick Airport

Overground service (from South Terminal) to Victoria (Central South), London Bridge (Central South East) and King's Cross (Central North East) Stations. Three train companies operate from Gatwick (Note: The Self-Service ticket machines are very confusing about this.).

1. Gatwick Express to Victoria Station (every 15 minutes during day, hourly at night). Journey Time: 30 mins. Cost: 10-15 pounds. Underground connections to Victoria, Circle and District Lines. For UCL, take the Victoria Line northbound to Warren Street.
2. South Central to Victoria Station (every 20 minutes during day). Journey Time: 40 mins. Underground connections to Victoria, Circle and District Lines. For UCL, take the Victoria Line northbound to Warren Street.
3. Thameslink to London Bridge and King's Cross (every 20 minutes during day). Journey Time: 40-50 mins. Underground connections to Northern Line (London Bridge) and to Piccadilly, Circle, Bakerloo, Hammersmith, Northern and Victoria Lines (King's Cross). For UCL, change to the underground at Farringdon (just cross to tube platform via footbridge) and take any tube westbound for Euston Square. (Note, unless you have a travel card, your overground ticket might not be valid also for the tube. You can either buy one at Farringdon, or ask for a excess fare at Euston Square).

### From Luton Airport

Bus connection to Luton Station. Overground train via Thameslink Service to King's Cross and London Bridge Stations, every 20 minutes during the day. (See paragraph above for underground connections). Journey Time: c. 40 minutes. For UCL, change to the underground at Farringdon (just cross to tube platform via footbridge) and take any tube westbound for Euston Square. (Note, unless you have a travel card, your overground ticket might not be valid also for the tube. You can either buy one at Farringdon, or ask for a excess fare at Euston Square).

### From Stansted Airport

Overground train service to Liverpool Street Station (Central East). Underground connections to Bakerloo, Circle, Hammersmith and Central Lines. Journey Time: c. 40 mins. Possible option for All-Day travel in London (see below). For UCL, take the Circle, Hammersmith or Metropolitan lines westbound for Euston Square).

### Eurostar

Arrive at Waterloo Station (Central South). Underground connections to Northern and Bakerloo Lines. For UCL, take the Northern line (northbound) for Warren Street.

### All-Day Travel Cards in London

These cards allow unlimited use of bus and underground services on the day of purchase. Prices vary according to areas in London in which you wish to travel. From Airports with only overground stations, it is possible to obtain a ticket combining travel to Central London and a Travel Card for the whole of London on the day of arrival. Check at the airport for details.

If you expect to make more than two underground journeys per day, it is likely that you will save money by purchasing a Travel Card.
